Angels Among Us Pet Rescue again passed Georgia Department of Agriculture regular inspection with praise for outstanding record keeping.

ATLANTA – Angels Among Us Pet Rescue Inc. (AAUPR) has again passed their routine yearly inspection of foster homes by the Georgia Department of Agriculture on March 17, 2015. “We were praised for our meticulous record keeping,” said Marcia Hockenbery, AAUPR Records Administrator. “It is the efforts of our volunteer home check team that should be recognized.”

AAUPR does not have an actual facility or shelter; all pets are housed in volunteer foster homes throughout the greater-Atlanta area.

Founded in 2009, Angels Among Us Pet Rescue Inc., a 501(c)(3) organization, is now the largest volunteer, foster-based pet rescue in the Southeastern US. The organization’s pet adoption rate is more than 40 per week. “The need to rescue pets from high kill shelters in Georgia is astronomical,” LuAnn Farrell, co-founder of the organization said. “Our ability to save more lives is limited only in our ability to find foster homes to care for them.”
